Strong Ties to the Community

Position / Role	Description
Local small business owner	Located in Henderson, Mark helped individuals, families, and small business owners set and reach financial goals. Serving widows, blue-collar workers, schoolteachers, hotel service workers, and anyone else who needed financial planning. For more than two decades, Mark got to know thousands of Nevadans on a very personal level.
Treasurer for the Salvation Army	Helped with the finances of the local branch of the Salvation Army, serving poor and needy families in the Community.
Assistant Professor at UNLV	Taught senior-level finance courses to students in the Hospitality College. Also taught leadership and military science to ROTC Cadets.
Director of Supply Chain Management at Nevada Power	Led a department of more than 100 people, including purchasing, contracting, warehouse, and small business development—Won national recognition for his efforts to support local small businesses.

Scout Master	Taught boys and young men to become good citizens in their families, communities, and nations.
Vice Chair, Senior Citizen Commission	Provided a voice for senior citizens living in Henderson. The Commission met regularly with city leaders and officials to help them understand the needs and desires of our senior community.
Church leader	Served as a youth pastor, Sunday School Teacher, missionary, and Bishop for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints.
Board member of Opportunity Village	Provided vocational training and employment opportunities for mentally challenged adults and children.
Substitute teacher	As a licensed teacher, taught elementary and high school students in CCSD and charter schools.
Vice Chair, Vietnamese American Association	Works with the Vietnamese and other Asian communities in Southern Nevada to bring awareness of their rich cultural heritage and contributions to our communities.
Member of veteran organizations	Meets with fellow military Veterans in local chapters of The Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW), the American Legion, and the Military Officers Association of America. Participates in events with Homes for Vets.
